In addition to the above, as evident from submitted attested copy of LL.M mark-sheets (all four semestesrs) and the copy of Degree Qualification, Sri Sumit Gutpa-I, completed his two-year LL.M. degree course in the year 2021 and was subsequently awarded the LL.M. Degree from Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi, on 13.01.2022, thus, the said qualification may be included in his service records, as is prayed for.

further, It is submitted that the Government of U.P. is the appointing authority of Judicial Officers, therefore, the qualification of LL.M. Degree may be included in the service records of Sri Sumit Gupta-I, aforesaid with the permission of Government of U.P., Lucknow. Hence, it seems proper to send the aforesaid online requisition dated 13.12.2022 Sri Sumit Gutpa-I, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Lucknow, to the Government of U.P. in order to obtain necessary orders.

If approved, the matter may kindly be placed before the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, Administrative Judge, Lucknow, for His Lordship's kind perusal and order to the effect that a copy of his online requisition along with the copy of mark-sheets (all four semesters) and of the Degree qualification of LL.M. as well as the attested copy of form of U. P. Nyayik Sewa of Sri Sumit Gutpa-I, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Lucknow,, may be sent to the Joint Secretary, Appointment Section-4, Government of U.P. Lucknow, for obtaining necessary order of the government of U.P. in the instant matter.
