May kindly see the online application of Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, (Rly.), Aligarh regarding grant of permission for writing a book titled "Procedural Laws for Judicial Services of All States with Model Answers" which he wishes to get published by a renowned publisher 'Lexis Nexus'.

In his application, Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh has stated that he has written a book titled "Procedural Laws for Judicial Services of All States with Model Answers" which he wishes to get published by a renowned publisher 'Lexis Nexus'. The draft book is strictly in accordance with law laid down in G.O. No 3143/II-B, dated 11.10.1968 and as per Rules 5 & 15 of Government Servant Conduct Rules 1956.

In this connection, it is submitted that permission to a Government servant to write & publish book may be accorded subject to the conditions laid down in G.O. No. O-3143/ II-B-1968, dated 11.12.1968, as reproduced below: -

(1) The book does not bear the imprimatur of Government

(2) The author's name appears on the first page of the book without his official designation. There may however, be no objection to the official designation to be given on the dust cover where the author is introduced to the public.

(3) The author gives a statement under his name on the first page of the book or at any other suitable place, that the author's views and comments in the book are entirely the responsibility of the author and Government are in no way concerned with the publication of the book.

(4) The author should also ensure that the; book does not contain any statement of fact or opinion which has any adverse criticism of any current or recent policy or action of the State Government or Central Government or Government of any other state or local authority.

(5) The work neither has not is likely to have any connection with the author's official position and no part of the income from the sale proceeds of the book need be credited to the general revenue.

(6) The book is a purely literary work which will help aspirants of judicial exams .

(7) The publisher has promised to provide graded royalty @10% net upto 2000 copies,@12.5% net upto 5000 copies and @15% net above 5000 copies sold, and that the copyright shall be with the author.

It is further submitted that as Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh has already submitted declaration that he will abide by the conditions of G.O. no. O-3134/II-B-1968 dated 11.12.1968 of rule 15 of U.P. Govt. Servant's Conduct Rules 1956. However, this case is not purely of publication of his own book for market circulation, but the subject matter relates to Procedural Laws for Judicial Services of All States with Model Answers, as such, the case requires such declaration and, his case may be considered, but, acceptance of the request of the officer for writing books and their Publication published by a renowned publisher 'Lexis Nexus' only is on discretion of the Court.

Under the facts and circumstances, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker, Senior Judge (J-1) for the purpose, for His Lordship's kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Sri Aishwarya Pratap Singh, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, (Rly.), Aligarh be granted permission for writing books and their Publication by a renowned publisher 'Lexis Nexus', as requested, subject to the conditions of G.O. No. O-3143/ II-B-1968, dated 11.12.1968?
