May kindly see the online requisition dated 10.01.2023 of Sri Sagar Tayal, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Firozabad requesting for inclusion of LL.M. qualification in his service records vide Case Id No. 27132023. In view of the above, Sri Sagar Tayal, has furnished his duly attested scanned copies of LL.M. Mark-sheets of all four semesters (consolidated as well as separate) and of the Degree Qualification, as supporting documents for the same.

An objection dated 16.01.2023 was raised by this office and in reply, Sri Sagar Tayal aforesaid has furnished the desired documents by attachment dated 18.01.2023.

In connection with the above, it is submitted that Sri Sagar Tayal, joined the U.P. Judicial Service on 01.12.2022, initially as Civil Judge (Junior Division), Firozabad. Further, it is relevant to mention here that Sri Sagar Tayal pursued his LL.M. two-year degree course from Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh, U.P., in the year 2018-2020, before joining the Judicial Service.

In addition to the above, as evident from submitted attested copy of LL.M mark-sheets (all four semesters) and the copy of Degree Qualification, Sri Sagar Tayal, completed his two-year LL.M. degree course in the year 2020 and was subsequently awarded the LL.M. Degree from Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh, U.P, on 13.01.2022, thus, the said qualification may be included in his service records, as is prayed for.

further, It is submitted that the Government of U.P. is the appointing authority of Judicial Officers, therefore, the qualification of LL.M. Degree may be included in the service records of Sri Sagar Tayal, aforesaid with the permission of Government of U.P., Lucknow. Hence, it seems proper to send the aforesaid online requisition dated 10.01.2023 of Sri Sagar Tayal, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Firozabad to the Government of U.P. in order to obtain necessary orders.

If approved, the matter may kindly be placed before the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rohit Ranjan Agarwal, Administrative Judge, Firozabad, for His Lordship's kind perusal and order to the effect that a copy of her online requisition along with the copy of mark-sheets (all four semesters) and of the Degree qualification of LL.M. as well as the attested copy of form of U. P. Nyayik Sewa of Sri Sagar Tayal, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Firozabad may be sent to the Joint Secretary, Appointment Section-4, Government of U.P. Lucknow, for obtaining necessary order of the government of U.P. in the instant matter, without entering into the fact that the University is recognised by University Grants Commission or not and without reserving any future claim of the officer regarding his qualification, if the University is not recognised for LL.M Degree Qualification.
