May kindly see the online application of Sri Virek Aggarwal, Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mathura who joined service on 12.01.2017, drawing gross salary of Rs. 1,52,970/- & take home salary of Rs. 1,18,939/- regarding information about purchase of a new Hyundai Ciaz car, intimated through application dated 26.01.2023.

Through his application, Sri Virek Aggarwal has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 27.01.2017 by giving point wise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from Rohan Motors Ltd., Mukund Nagar, Ghaziabad who is an authorised dealer, for Rs. 9,32,600/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is that the total amount of the car is stated to have been paid out of his own S.B. A/c, source of which is that prior to joining of judicial service, during practice as as advocate, he had advanced certain amount of cash (total 8.5 lakh) to his brother and HUF family fund, from income during practice, which was received back by him (copy of passbook can be seen as attachment). It is pertinent to mention here that he had joined the judicial services on 12.1.2017 and was on Dias training till 28.3.2017 and held the court for 2 days only in the financial year 2017. Having been freshly joined, during that period, he was not familiar with the rules regarding intimation of the movable property. As such, he had already disclosed the above moveable property in property statements for the financial years 2017 and subsequent years. The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in URT OF JUD his court.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Piyush Agrawal, Administrative Judge, Mathura also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956", for the district Mathura, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24(2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
