## <u>Registrar (J) (Budget)</u>

May kindly see the application of Sri Amit Veer Singh, Additional District & Sessions Judge, (POCSO), Sonbhadra by which he has submitted information about getting a rifle transferred into his name from his father's name.

In his application, Sri Amit Veer Singh has stated that due to old age of his father Mr. Chandra Vir Singh, his licenced weapon N.P.B rifle has gotten transferred in his (officer's) name without consideration, for which DM Rampur has issued licence to the officer (copy of 'licence' of the officer as well as 'consent letter' of his father can be seen as attachment).

In this connection, it is submitted that the relevant rule relating to transfer of movable property [Rule-24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct Rule-1956] runs as under:

24(2)- "A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority.

Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

In the instant case, the officer has already transferred the rifle into his name from his father's name without taking prior permission of this Court due to his father's old age. Now, the matter required regularization and it is desirable that he may be granted ex-post facto permission for the same. However, this aspect is also on the discretion of the Court.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Chandra Kumar Rai, Administrative Judge, Sonbhadra also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Sonbhadra, for His Lordship's kind perusal & if His Lordship approves, Sri Amit Veer Singh, Additional District & Sessions Judge, (POCSO), Sonbhadra may be granted ex-post facto permission about getting the rifle transferred from his father's name into his name.
