May kindly see the online application of Smt. Shaleen Mishra, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Sultanpur regarding grant of permission to visit Thailand along with her husband i.e. from 05.06.2023 to 14.06.2023 i.e. during ten day recess period of the summer vacation in the month of June, 2023.

In her application, Smt. Shaleen Mishra has stated that she wishes to visit Thailand along with her husband during ten day recess period of the Summer Vacation in the month of June, 2023 i.e from 05.06.2023 to 14.06.2023. She has also stated that she wishes to go to the above mentioned country for tour purpose only and all the expenses of the the officer would be borne from her salary. She has also submitted her declaration, which are as follows:-

- 1- That by her abroad visit no dilemma is likely to be created before Government of India or Government of U.P.
- 2- That such type of request for aboard visit has not been refused earlier.
- 3- That she has never visited any foreign country after joining the services.
4. That all the expenditure of the visit would be borne from salary account number 33648984164 (showing balance amount of Rs 4,79,939/-).

She has, therefore, requested to grant her permission to visit Thailand alongwith her husband.

In this connection, it is submitted that grant of permission to visit abroad is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 and in accordance with Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017. As per reports, provided by concerned sections no vigilance/ departmental enquiry is pending against Smt. Shaleen Mishra. As per the point no. (1) of Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017, Abroad tour by any officer shall not be availed of during working days of the Hon'ble Court or during the period of suspension/departmental proceedings, except in case of medical treatment of himself/ herself, spouse or dependent, or in special circumstances, and tours which are sponsored and/ or approved by the State/ Central Government during certain fixed span of time and does not fall during vacation. In these eventualities the Judicial officers shall seek permission before applying for VISA. Now, in the instant case the officer is going to visit Thailand alongwith her husband during recess for tourism purpose from 05.06.2023 to 14.06.2023, thus, this trip appears to be a pleasure trip which falls during summer vacation. However, it is on the discretion of the Hon'ble High Court either to grant her permission or to pass any other order which deems to be proper. In this connection it is also submitted that in the Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter dated 27.05.2017, it has been settled that for the purpose of grant of such permission the competent authority for the judicial officers is Hon'ble the Administrative Judge of the District concerned, for the Judicial officers posted in judgeship or on the District of any deputation post, subject to approval by Hon'ble The Chief Justice or any member of the Administrative Committee authorised by Hon'ble The Chief Justice. Recently, vide order dated 23.04.2023 regarding reconstitution of different Committees, Hon'ble The Chief Justice has been pleased to form a single Hon'ble Judge Committee i.e. Hon'ble Senior Judge (J-1) to deal with the matter of grant of permission to Judicial Officers to visit abroad

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter may be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Saral Srivastava, Administrative Judge, Sultanpur for kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Smt. Shaleen Mishra, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Sultanpur may be granted permission to visit Thailand alongwith her husband from 05.06.2023 to 14.06.2023 i.e. during summer vacation in June 2023, for tourism purpose, as requested, subject to approval by Hon'ble The Senior Judge (J-1), as per Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017 and order dated 23.04.2023 of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, as mentioned above with the condition that proper charge of Government records or cash, if any, or any government property with her, may be handed over by her before proceeding abroad?

Or

To pass any other order, which His/ Her Lordship deems fit and proper.
