In his application, Sri Manish Arora has stated that vide online case Id no. S00024902022. Hon'ble High Court has been pleased to allow him to apply and appear in the Punjab civil services (Judicial Branch) Prelims examination 2022, advertisement no. 2022103 and he had appeared in the same prelims examination and has been shortlisted as a successful candidate in the result (Copy of result showing his name and roll number at page 163 at serial number 4024 can be seen as attachment). He has further stated that now its Mains examination is scheduled to be held on 2nd to 4th of June 2023 (copy of the announcement can also be seen attachment). He has, therefore, requested to Hon'ble Court to grant him permission to appear in the aforesaid Mains examination of Punjab Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination 2022.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined the U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 16.12.2019. Earlier, the officer had been granted permission for his appearance in Prelims examinations of Punjab Civil Services (Judicial Branch) examination 2022 vide order dated 22.11.2022 of Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Mathura.
