May kindly see the online application received from Smt. Swati Chandra, Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Auraiya regarding information about acceptance of gift money of Rs. 12,00,000/- from her father-in-law.

The officer in her application has stated that her father in law Sri Jai Pal Singh, S/o Late Shri Prabhati Ram, R/o D-16, Rameshwar Park, Loni, Ghaziabad has gifted her Rs. 12,00,000/- on 31-05-2023 through two cheques, cheque no. 859231 of Rs. 6,00,000/- & cheque no. 859232 of Rs. 6,00,000/- out of his SB A/c No.- 10280431941, SBI, Ghaziabad due to natural love and affection towards her as a daugher-in-law (copy of cheques & gift deed can be seen as attachment). It is therefore, requested that the information regarding gifting of the aforementioned money may be placed before this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal.

It is also submitted that the relevant rule relating to gift (Rule 11 of the U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956) runs as under :

11. Gifts:-A government servant shall not without previous approval of Government :-

(a) Accept directly or indirectly on his own behalf or on behalf of any other persons, or

(b) Permit any member of his family who is dependent on him, to accept any gift, gratuity or reward from any person other than a close relative.

It is further submitted that the amount of Rs. 12,00,000/- had been gifted to her by her fatherin-law out of natural love and affection and is the close relative being father & daughter-in-law in relation. Thus, there seems to be nothing objectionable as per rule referred to above.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ram Manohar Narayan Mishra, Administrative Judge, Auraiya, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Auraiya, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule (11) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
