May kindly see the online application of Sri Ashok Kumar Srivastava, Joint Registrar (J) (S&A), High Court, Allahabad (Prayagraj) who has joined his service on 20.04.2009, drawing gross salary of Rs. 1,98,692/- & take home salary of Rs. 1,45,560/- regarding information about purchase of a new Skoda Slavia car, allotted reg. no. UP 70 GM 3731, intimated through application dated 28.07.2023.

Through his application, Sri Ashok Kumar Srivastava has submitted information about purchase of a new car on 30.03.2023 by giving point wise details as per Court's C.L. no. 25/Admin(A) dated 13.07.1998, according to which the car has been purchased by him from 2/1/1A PD Tandon Road, Civil Lines, Prayagraj who is an authorized dealer, for Rs. 14,65,000/- (copy of invoice can be seen as attachment), source of money of which is that Rs. 12,00,000/- has been taken as loan from SBI, repayable in 60 EMIs of Rs. 19,521/- (copy of 'loan arrangement letter' can be seen as attachment), Rs. 15,000/- paid as booking amount through card swapping on 25.03.2023 & Rs. 2,50,000/- paid out of his own S.B. A/c (copy of statement of A/c can be seen as attachment). The dealer from whom the said car has been purchased by the officer is neither related to him in any way nor any case is pending/decided in his court.

It is also noteworthy to mention here that normally such type of matters are being submitted to Hon'ble the Administrative Judges concerned but as the officer is posted in this Hon'ble Court as Joint Registrar (J) (S&A), High Court, Allahabad and as per resolution passed in the meeting of the Hon'ble Administrative Committee held on 12.07.2013, he is under the exclusive control of the Hon'ble The Chief Justice and as such the matter is likely to be placed before Hon'ble The Chief Justice.

Under the facts & details mentioned above and as the officer has purchased the car from a regular & reputed dealer and has submitted sufficient details about purchase and source of money, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble The Chief Justice for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24(2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
