

Registrar (J) (Budget)

May kindly see the online application of Sri Nitendra Kumar, Registrar (J) (Accounts), High Court, Lucknow Bench, Lucknow regarding issuance of 'Identity Certificate' in his favour for obtaining Passport.

In his application, Sri Nitendra Kumar has stated that he desires to apply for Indian passport and for obtaining the same 'Identity Certificate' from the Hon'ble Court is required. Smt. Arti Singh (Wife) and Master Aksh Shaurya (Son) are dependent family members of the officer. He has also enclosed required details/ declaration on 'Affidavit', which may kindly be seen as attachment. He has, therefore requested for issuance of 'No Objection/ Identity Certificate' in his favour for obtaining Passport.

In this connection, it is submitted that issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' i.e. 'Identity Certificate' on new proforma for obtaining Passport is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999. Here it is also to submit that as per reports, no vigilance/ departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Nitendra Kumar. His request appears to be considerable, as he has submitted required details and papers in this connection. Here, it is also pertinent to mention here that normally such type of matters are submitted to Hon'ble the Administrative Judges concerned but as the applicant is a Judicial Officer, presently posted on deputation in Hon'ble High Court. As per the resolution passed in the meeting of the Hon'ble Administrative Committee held on 12.07.2013, he is under exclusive administrative control of Hon'ble The Chief Justice and as such this matter is likely to be placed before Hon'ble The Chief Justice.

Under the facts and circumstances, mentioned above, if approved, the instant matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble The Chief Justice for kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, the 'Identity Certificate' be issued, offline, in duplicate, under the signature of Registrar (Judicial) (Budget) in favour of Sri Nitendra Kumar, Registrar (J) (Accounts), High Court Lucknow Bench, Lucknow, as requested, for obtaining Passport with the direction of the Hon'ble Court that he should take prior permission of the Hon'ble Court before proceeding abroad?
