## <u>Registrar (J) Budget</u>

May kindly see the online application of Sri Anandesh Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amroha regarding grant of permission to get transferred firearm in his name from his father's name.

In this application, the officer has stated that the sudden demise of his father took place on 19th february 2019. His father has made a testamentary succession of all his movable and immovable property through registered will in his favour which includes one fire arm of single barrel also. He has deposited that fire arm through challan in a registered gun shop after the death of his father as he does not have license to carry that firearm. In anticipation of getting permission, he has initiated the proceedings of getting arm license being transferred in his favour through succession. He has attached the self attested copies of essential documents in this regard. He has, therefore, requested the Court to grant him permission to get transferred firearm in his name from his father's name.

In this connection, it is submitted that the relevant rule relating to transfer of movable property Rule-24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct (Amendment) Rule-1998] runs as under: -

"A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority;

Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

It is further submitted that the officer has also enclosed copy of licence, release order & copy of challan which can be seen as attachment. Now, as the officer has requested for grant of permission to get transferred single barrel gun, in his name from his father's name, he may be granted the permission, as requested, as per the rule referred to above, if the Court deemed fit and proper.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Krishan Pahal, Administrative Judge, Amroha, also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Amroha, for His Lordship's kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Sri Anandesh Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amroha be granted permission to get transferred single barrel gun in his name from his father's name, as requested, with the direction that he may furnish copies of the relevant papers of transaction after its completion?
