May kindly see the online application of Sri Vipin Kumar-I, Principal Judge, Family Court, Agra regarding information about acceptance of gift money from her mother.

In his application he has stated that his mother (Mrs. Sushila Rani Sharma W/o Late Mr. R.D. Sharma, age about 86 years is a Pension Holder) has gifted Rs. 2,50,000/- to the officer on 18.02.2023(copy of statement of the officer's A/c can be seen as attachment), Rs. 2,50,000 to Mrs. Rohini Sharma, wife of the officer on 19.02.2023 (copy of statement of Rohini Sharma's A/c can be seen as attachment), Rs. 4,00,000/- to Madhav Sharma, Son of the officer on 21.02.2023 (copy of statement of A/c can be seen as attachment), from A/C no 3654000100062430, Punjab National Bank, Motibagh, Bulandshahr on account of natural love and affection. (Copy of gift deed & statement of A/c of his mother's can be seen as attachment). It is therefore, requested that the information regarding acceptance of gift money may be placed before this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal.

It is also submitted that the relevant rule relating to gift (Rule 11 of the U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956) runs as under:

11. Gifts:-A government servant shall not without previous approval of Government :-

(a) Accept directly or indirectly on his own behalf or on behalf of any other persons, or

(b) Permit any member of his family who is dependent on him, to accept any gift, gratuity or reward from any person other than a close relative.

It is further submitted that as the money had been gifted by his mother to the officer, the officer's son (Madhav Sharma), and the officer's wife (Mrs. Rohini Sharma) out of natural love and affection and is the closest blood relative Thus, there seems to be nothing objectionable as per rule referred to above.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vivek Chaudhary, Administrative Judge, Agra, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Agra for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule (11) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
