May kindly see the online application of Sri Rahul Anand-III, Civil Judge (Junior Division) (Fast Track Court), Pilibhit regarding grant of permission to visit United Arab Emirates (UAE) for tourism purpose only alongwith his wife from 24.12.2023 to 31.12.2023.

In his application dated 17.10.2023, Sri Rahul Anand-III has stated that he wishes to visit United Arab Emirates (UAE) for tourism purpose only alongwith his wife Sushma Rani who is a practicing Doctor, working as a Radiologist in Sai Sukhda Hospital, Bareilly. He has also stated that he wishes to travel U.A.E. from 24.12.2023 to 31.12.2023 i.e. during winter vacation in December 2023 and the tour expenses per person will be Rs. 1,00,000/- approximately which would be borne by the officer and his wife from their salary (copy of account statement of the officer, showing balance amount of Rs. 4,40,860/- and his wife; showing balance amount of Rs. 2,23,271/-can be seen as attachment). He has further added that in order to apply for Visa /booking and initiate other formalities, he needs permission from Hon'ble Court to visit U.A.E.. He has also submitted his declaration which are as follows:-

1. That by his abroad visit no dilemma is likely to create before the Government of India or Government of Uttar Pradesh.
2. That such type of request for abroad visit has not been refused earlier.
3. That he has visited United Kingdom during the period of 10.06.2023 to 20.06.2023 earlier after obtaining due permission by the Hon'ble High Court.

The officer has also attached the copies of his wife and his own passport. He has, therefore, most humbly requested to place his request before Hon'ble Court to grant him permission to visit U.A.E. alongwith his wife.

In this connection, it is submitted that grant of permission to visit abroad is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 and in accordance with Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017. As per reports, provided by concerned sections, no vigilance/ departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Rahul Anand-III. As per the point no. (1) of Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017, Abroad tour by any officer shall not be availed of during working days of the Hon'ble Court or during the period of suspension/departmental proceedings, except in case of medical treatment of himself/ herself, spouse or dependent, or in special circumstances, and tours which are sponsored and/ or approved by the State/ Central Government during certain fixed span of time and does not fall during vacation. In these eventualities the Judicial officers shall seek permission before applying for VISA. Now, in the instant case the officer is going to visit Dubai alongwith his wife from 24.12.2023 to 31.12.2023, which includes Sunday and winter holidays for tourism purpose, thus, this trip appears to be a pleasure trip which falls during non working days of the Court. However, it is on the discretion of the Hon'ble High Court either to grant him permission or to pass any order which deems to be proper. In this connection it is also submitted that in the Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter dated 27.05.2017, it has been settled that for the purpose of grant of such permission the competent authority for the judicial officers is Hon'ble the Administrative Judge of the District concerned, for the Judicial officers posted in judgeship or on the District of any deputation post, subject to approval by Hon'ble The Chief Justice or any member of the Administrative Committee authorised by Hon'ble The Chief Justice. Recently, vide order dated 23.04.2023 regarding reconstitution of different Committees, Hon'ble The Chief Justice has been pleased to form a single Hon'ble Judge Committee i.e. Hon'ble Senior Judge (J-1) to deal with the matter of grant of permission to Judicial Officers to visit abroad.

May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter may be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sanjay Kumar Pachori, Administrative Judge, Pilibhit for kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Sri Rahul Anand-III, Civil Judge (Junior Division) (Fast Track Court), Pilibhit may be granted permission to visit U.A.E. along with his wife from 24.12.2023 to 31.12.2023 for tourism purpose, as requested, subject to approval by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manoj Kumar Gupta, Senior Judge (J-1), as per Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 16/ IV-f-101/ Admin (A)/ dated 27.05.2017 and order dated 23.04.2023 of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, as mentioned above with the condition that proper charge of Government records or cash, if any, or any government property with him, may be handed over by him before proceeding abroad?

Or

To pass any other order, which His Lordship deems fit and proper.
