May kindly see the online application of Sri Tarun Kumar, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rath-Hamipur regarding information about sale of his old Maruti Suzuki Swift car, intimated through his application dated 10.01.2024.

In his application, Sri Tarun Kumar has stated that he had a Maruti Swift Car bearing registration number DL1CX4559 (copy of RC can be seen as attachment) in his name. Last year, he encountered a minor accident with that car, resulting in some continuous problem persisting with the car. Then he has decided to sell it off. Thus, on 31.12.2023, he has sold his car to CARS 24 (Regular and Reputed dealer)(copy of vehicle delivery acknowledgment receipt can be seen as attachment). The sale price of the said vehicle i.e. Rs. 1,89,277/- is stated to have been transferred by CARS 24 (copy of passbook and payment receipt can be seen as attachments). The purchaser is neither related to him in any manner nor any of his case is decided or pending in his Court.. The officer has therefore, intimated about the sale of his old car for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has sold his car through a regular and reputed dealer. This seems to be nothing objectionable as per the Rule-24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct Rules, 1956, which is as follows:-

24 (2):- "A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority;

Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vikas Budhwar, Administrative Judge, Hamirpur also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956" for the district Hamirpur, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
