May kindly see the online application of Dr. Ajay Kumar-II, District & Sessions Judge, Moradabad by which he has informed about acceptance of immovable properties by his wife from her deceased mother.

In his application, Dr. Ajay Kumar has stated that the wife of the officer Smt. Saroj Bala has inheried two properties i.e. 1/4 th share in 77/107 share of her late mother (Late Smt. Mahender Kaur) in Khewat No. 181, village Hartari, Hadbast No. 36, Tehsil Panipat, Distt. Panipat & 2/21 share of her late mother in Khewat No. 329, Village Gadiwara, Hadbast No. 30, Tehsil Panipat, Distt. Panipat (copy of 'Mutation Deed' & 'Death Certficate' of Smt. Mahender Kaur can be seen as attachment). The officer has, therefore, submitted the information about acceptance of immovable properties by his wife from her deceased mother for kind perusal of the Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, the relevant extract of rule relating to gift (Rule 11 of the U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956) is as under :-

11.Gifts:- A government servant shall not without previous approval of Government :(a) Accept directly or indirectly on his own behalf or on behalf of any other persons, or
(b) Permit any member of his family who is dependent on him, to accept any gift, gratuity or reward from any person other than a close relation.

It is further submitted that as the plots have been been gifted by the mother to her daughter (officer's wife) out of natural love and affection & being mother & daughter in relation. Thus, there appears to be nothing objectionable as per above mentioned rule.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajeev Misra, Administrative Judge, Moradabad, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Moradabad, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule (11) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
