May kindly see the online application of Sri Sharjil Khan, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Maharajganj regarding information about transfer of Baleno Delta car from his wife's name into his name.

In his application, Sri Sharjil Khan has stated that his wife (Mrs. Saba Khanam) has transferred Baleno Delta Car UP53CJ 6144 in his name as the vehicle is brought in his use for discharge of official duties. The said vehicle was purchased by his wife on 17.02.2017. He has joined UP Judicial Service in 14-06-2018. Vehicle has been transferred in his name on 19.02.2020 (Copy of 'Consent Letter' from the side of his wife can be seen as attachment). (Copy of RC & insurance can be seen as attachment). The officer has submitted information for kind perusal of Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that the aforementioned car appears to have been purchased by his wife before the joining of judicial service by the officer. It is further submitted that Rule 24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct Rule-1956 relating to transfer of movable property runs as under: -

24 (2). "A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority; Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a

Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

In view of the above, the information so submitted by the officer is likely to be acceptable, as the car has been transferred to him by his wife, who are husband & wife in relation. Thus, there appears to be nothing objectionable.

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajit Singh, Administrative Judge, Maharajganj also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956", for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24(2) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
