May kindly see the online application received from Sushri Nagma Khan, Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Firozabad regarding information about transfer of Maruti Dzire VDI car from her father's name into her own.

Sushri Nagma Khan in her application has stated that her father has got transferred the RC of his Maruti Dzire VDI car bearing reg. no. UP 38 L 0490 in her favour on 14.02.2024. Copy of both old & new RC can be seen as attachment. She has received the car as gift from him. Copy of 'Consent Letter' of her father can be seen as attachment. It is therefore, requested that the information regarding gifting as well as transfer of the aforementioned car from her father's name into her own may be placed before kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that the relevant rule relating to transfer of movable property [Rule-24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct Rule-1956] & rule relating to gift (Rule 11 of the U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956) runs as under:

11. Gifts:-A government servant shall not without previous approval of Government :- (a) Accept directly or indirectly on his own behalf or on behalf of any other persons, or (b) Permit any member of his family who is dependent on him, to accept any gift, gratuity or reward from any person other than a close relative.

It is further submitted that the Maruti Dzire VDI car has been gifted to her by her father out of natural love and affection and is the closest blood relative being father & daughter in relation. Thus, there seems to be nothing objectionable as per rule referred to above.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rohit Ranjan Agarwal, Administrative Judge, Firozabad, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Firozabad, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule (11) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
