May kindly see the online application of Sri Viresh Chandra, Additional District & Sessions Judge(FTC), Hapur regarding information about sale of his old Maruti Ciaz car, intimated through his application dated 12.03.2024.

In his application, Sri Viresh Chandra has stated that he had purchased a Maruti Ciaz car, bearing registration number UP16 CD4466 (copy of RC can be seen as attachment namely- Car Details and representation, page no.3). He has also furnished the information regarding purchase of aforementioned car in his property statement (financial year 2018-2020). Then he has decided to sell it off. Thus, on 17.01.2024, he has sold his car to Akanksha Automobiles Pvt. Ltd. (Regular and Reputed dealer), Moradabad. The sale price of the said vehicle i.e. Rs. 7,00,000/- (copy of payment receipt can be seen as attachment namely- Car Details and representation, page no.2), was transferred to his account by Akanksha Automobiles Pvt. Ltd (copy of statement of A/c can be seen as attachment namely- Car Details and representation, page no.6). The purchaser is neither related to him in any manner nor any of his case is decided or pending in his Court.. The officer has therefore, intimated about the sale of his old car for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has sold his car through a regular and reputed dealer. This seems to be nothing objectionable as per the Rule-24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct Rules, 1956, which is as follows:-

24 (2):- "A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority;

Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ashutosh Srivastava, Administrative Judge, Hapur also nominated for "Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers wherein permission/information for sale or purchase of movable/immovable property and permission/information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956" for the District Hapur, for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule 24 (2) U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
