<u>Registrar (J) (Budget)</u>

May kindly see the order dated 23.08.2024 of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Banerji, Administrative Judge, Agra, passed in the matter of 'Issuance of Identity certificate for obtaining passport' to Sushri Garima Saxena, Judicial Magistrate, Agra. The order of His Lordship is reproduced as below:-

"Paragraph 7 of the Affidavit and Clause (e) of the undertaking are improperly worded. Registry is not pointing out the mistakes. Explanation is required.

In compliance of His Lordship's order dated 23.08.2024 regarding submission of explanation about improperly worded paragraph 7 of the Affidavit and clause (e) of the undertaking submitted by the officer, the office most humbly submitted that the office due to rush of work and by mistake, had not marked the improper wordings. The office felt ashamed of the mistake. The inconvenience caused to His Lordship is deeply regretted. The office assures that in future such types of mistakes are certainly avoided.

Under the facts and circumstances mentioned above, office requests with folded hands to His Lordship to accept unconditional apology in the matter.

May, therefore, if approved, the matter be placed before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Banerji, Administrative Judge, Agra for His Lordship's kind perusal, acceptance of explanation of the office, and further orders in the matter of 'No Objection/ Identity Certificate' in favour of the officer for obtaining/ renewal of Passport, as prayed.
