May kindly see the online application of Sri Sudeep Kumar Jaiswal, Additional District Judge (POCSO), Shahjahanpur by which he has submitted information about acceptance of Toyota Innova car as gift by his brother-in-law to him.

In his application, Sudeep Kumar Jaiwal has stated that his widower father-in-law Sri Ganga Sagar Prasad Gupta aged about 75 years, lives with his family as both of his brothers-in-law & sister-in-law have settled abroad. Moreover, his Dubai based brother-in-law Sri Sandeep Jaiswal, vide gift deed dated 29.04.2004, has gifted his Toyota Innova car, bearing Registration no. UP 65 EK1281 to him and the officer has got the said vehicle, transferred to his own name. He has, therefore, requested to place the matter before the Hon'ble Court for kind perusal.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has also submitted copy of 'registration certificate' both old & new as well as the copy of 'Consent Letter' from the side of his brother-in-law. The relevant rule relating to gift i.e. Rule 11 of the U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules-1956 runs as under: -

- 11. Gifts:- A government servant shall not without previous approval of Government:-
- (a) Accept directly or indirectly on his own behalf or on behalf of any other persons, or
- (b) Permit any member of his family who is dependent on him, to accept Any gift, gratuity or reward from any person other than a close relative.

In view of the above, the information so submitted by the officer is likely to be acceptable, as the car has been gifted to him by his close relative i.e. brother-in-law, which is quite acceptable.

Under the facts & circumstances, may, therefore, if approved, the matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Saurabh Shyam Shamshery, Administrative Judge, Shahjahanpur, also nominated for 'Disposal of the matters of the Judicial Officers, wherein permission/ information for sale or purchase of movable/ immovable property and permission/ information to accept gift under U.P. Government Servants' Conduct Rules 1956" for the district Shahjahanpur for His Lordship's kind perusal and information under Rule (11) of U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956?
