May kindly see the online application of Sri Vishal Thakur, Civil Judge (Junior Division) (Fast Track Court), Budaun by which he has requested for grant of permission to appear in Mains Examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination, 2023-2024.

In his application, Sri Vishal Thakur has stated that in the light of Hon'ble High Court's letter no. 9049/IV-5693(Loose)/Admin(A-4)/ Dated 03.07.2024 he is submitting the application for appearing in the aforesaid exam through the online portal. In his application the officer has stated that he had taken Charge on 11.03.2024 (charge certificate can be seen as attachment) and before that he has appeared in the preliminary examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) examination 2023-2024 (was scheduled on 03.03.2024). He has also stated that he has been qualified for the Mains (written) examination of the said exam, which is scheduled on 12th, 13th an 14th July at Panchkula (Haryana). He has also enclosed the admit card of the Mains and Preliminary examinations, which can be seen as attachments. He has therefore requested to grant him permission to appear in the Mains Examination of the aforesaid examination.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined the U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 11.03.2024. It is pertinent to mention here that as the officer has earlier applied through offline mode and through Hon'ble Court's letter dated 03.07.2024, he was asked to submit the same application through online portal. Now, as the officer has already appeared in the preliminary examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) 2023-2024 prior to joining the U.P. Nyayik Sewa and wants to appear in the Mains examination of the same, therefore it appears to be desirable to accord him permission to appear in the Haryana Judicial Services (Mains) Examination 2023-24 stated to be scheduled on 12.07.2024, 13.07.2024 & 14.07.2024; as he has qualified the preliminary examination of the same, subject to the following conditions:-

1. Government work should not suffer in any way.
 2. No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
 3. The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time the government servant neglect his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.
- May, therefore, if approved, the instant matter be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Saurabh Lavania, Administrative Judge, Budaun for his Lordship's kind perusal and if approved by His Lordship, Sri Vishal Thakur, Civil Judge (Junior Division) (Fast Track Court), Budaun be granted permission to appear in the mains examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch) Examination 2023-24, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
