In her application, Sushri Harshita has stated that her research paper titled "A study to examine the responses of the criminal justice system to revenge pornography in India: Effective measures for reformation and sensitisation" in "The Journal of Campus Law Centre (ISSN: 2321-4716)" which is a refereed journal published by the Campus Law Centre, Faculty of Law, University of Delhi, India which is also her alma mater. The paper has been co-authored with Shashwat Singh, Advocate. She wishes to humbly inform that this research paper is not part of her Ph.D. and has been written separately. Although the last date for the same is July 31, 2020 but she has not submitted the research paper on or before 31.07.2020 as the application for permission was pending. Thus, she wishes to further publish this paper in anticipation of Hon'ble Court's permission. The research paper & abstract for the same can be seen as attachment. In this connection, it is submitted that such permission to a Government servant may be accorded subject to the conditions laid down in G.O. No. O-3143/ II-B-1968, dated 11.12.1968, as reproduced below: -

- (2) The author's name appears on the first page of the research paper without his official designation.
- (3) The views and comments in the research paper are entirely the responsibility of the author and Government are in no way concerned with the publication.
- (4) The research paper does not contain any statement of fact or opinion which has any adverse criticism of any current or recent policy or action of the State Government or Central Government or Government of any other state or local authority.
- (5) The publication of research paper involves no royalty or monetary benefit.

It is further submitted that as Sushri Harshita has already submitted declaration (online on date 02.01.2021) that she will abide by the conditions of G.O. no. O-3134/II-B-1968 dated 11.12.1968 of rule 15 of U.P. govt. servant's conduct rules 1956, her case may be considered, but, acceptance of the request of the officer to get published the research paper is on discretion of the Court.

Under the facts and circumstances, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pritinker Diwaker, Nominated Judge for the purpose, for His Lordship's kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Sushri Harshita, Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Hamirpur be granted permission to submit her research paper titled "A study to examine the responses of the criminal justice system to revenge pornography in India: Effective measures for reformation and sensitisation.", in "The Journal of Campus Law Centre (ISSN: 2321-4716)" which is a referred journal published by the Campus Law Centre, Faculty of Law, University of Delhi, India as requested, subject to the conditions of G.O.
