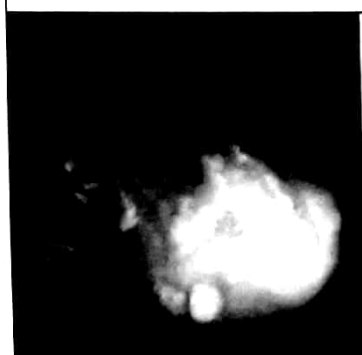

ERCP REPORT

Indication : Chronic calcific pancreatitis, for endotherapy procedure

Procedure done under sedation in monitored anaesthetist care

Findings :

Scope passed till D II and ampulla identified, previously placed stent was removed

Selective PD cannulation was done

Pancreatogram showed a dilated duct with ectetic side ducts and few filling defects in the head region, no stricture seen in PD

Basket was trolled in PD and small stones were removed, basket was swept in PD and clearence was confirmed

Free flow of the juice was seen

No stent placed in PD

No immeidate post procedural complication

Conclusion :

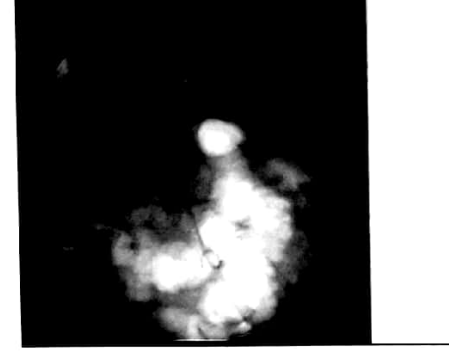
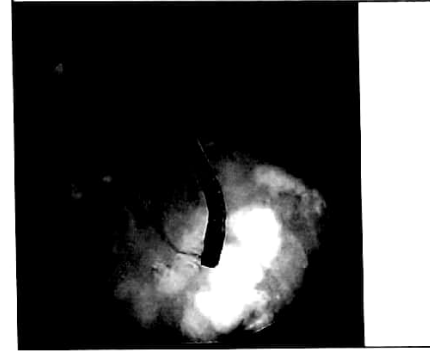
PD stones removed, stent free trial

ERCP REPORT

Indication : Chronic calcific pancreatitis, for stent exchange
Procedure done under sedation in monitored anaesthetist care

Findings :

Scope passed till D II, previously placed stent was removed
PD cannulation was done, pancreatic juice sent for cytology
Pancreatogram showed a grossly dilated PD above the level of genu with filling defects in the head region
Basket was trolled and multiple small concretions were retrieved
A 7Fr X 10cm SPT stent placed, draining well
No immediate post procedural complication was seen

Conclusion :

Stent exchanged

Advice : Watch for pain abdomen, oral antibiotics for 5 days, reassess for stent exchange after 3 months
