ULTRA SONOGRAPHIC REPORT WHOLE ABDOMEN

LIVER- It is mild enlarged in size, with normal parenchymal echotexture. No focal SOL is seen. No IHBRD. Hepatic & portal veins are normal.

GALLBLADDER- Severely contracted GB. Multiple stones of varying sizes are seen in GB. GB wall thickness up to 3.5mm. No focal mass lesion is seen. CBD is not dilated.

PANCREAS- It is normal in size, shape & parenchymal echotexture. No focal SOL is seen. PD is not dilated.

SPLEEN- It is normal in size, shape & parenchymal echotexture. Splenic flexure is clear.

RIGHT KIDNEY- It is normal in size, shape & echotexture. A small cystic lesion size approx 35x30mm seen in right kidney. No hydronephrosis is seen. CMD is maintained. Ureter is not dilated.

LEFT KIDNEY- It is normal in size, shape & echotexture. No focal SOL is seen. No calculus. No hydronephrosis is seen. CMD is maintained. Ureter is not dilated.

BLADDER- It is well distended with anechoic lumen. No calculus. No focal mass lesion is seen. B L UVJ clear. F.Cath is seen.

PROSTATE- Enlarged prostate size approx 53x45x52mm & weight approx 47gms with normal echotexture.

RETROPERITONEUM- No evidence of aortic, para aortic lymph nodes are seen. No free fluid.

INFERENCE-

- No cholelithiasis.
- Chronic cholecystitis with cholelithiasis.
- Small right renal cortical cyst size approx 35x30mm.
- Prostatic hypertrophy Grade 'III'.
- RV, CBD, PANCREAS, SPLEEN, LEFT KIDNEY, RETROPERITONEUM ARE NORMAL IN SONOGRAPHIC APPEARANCE.
