
Subject: Request for Stay at Aligarh on empathetic Grounds.

01. Reference is made to Hon'ble High Court's Circular Letter No. 24/Admin. (Services)/2021, dated September 24, 2021.
02. With Utmost respect, I humbly submit that I was initially posted to Aligarh Judgeship from Gonda, vide Hon'ble High Court's Notification no. 2866/Admin. Services 2018, dated August 04, 2018.
03. It is also submitted that my husband is in Personal Business and frequently moves to different cities and countries for his business tours. My Brother in law is also settled in Cape Town, South Africa. My mother in law is suffering from multiple chronic diseases such as gastro, intestinal, uterine and rheumatoid arthritis. She is residing with me and getting regular treatment from Sir Gangaram Hospital, Delhi by Dr. Anil Arora (Gastroenterologist), since 2017, her major surgery is also expected. Due to frequent business tours of my husband she is completely dependent on me and there is no one at home to take care of my aged mother in law. My two kids are of tender age one is of 07 years & another one is 05 years old. Alongwith my mother in-law I have to look after my kids too. Thus, there is no one at home to take care of my mother and my two kids.

At this point of exigency and above elucidated facts, I humbly request that if my transfer is stayed for next one year, it will prove to be great help for my mother & my kids and with this stay I shall be able to discharge my official duties and matrimonial obligations with utmost ease and effectiveness.
05. Therefore, I humbly request that my representation be put up before the Hon'ble Court for kind and sympathetic consideration of my earnest request for stay at Aligarh on humanitarian ground for one year.
