## Course In The Hospital & Discussion

Patient was admitted under Dr. Rajesh Taneja (Senior Consultant Urology). All relevant investigations were done. After pre anaesthesia checkup, physician clearance by Dr.V K Aneja (Senior Consultant Internal Medicine) and written informed consent, patient underwent the below mentioned procedure.

Procedure:

Cystoscopy + biopsy under general anesthesia on 29.11.2022.

Intraoperative findings:

Meatus normal

Urethra: Friable.

Bilateral Ureteric orifices and Trigonenormal.

Urinary Bladder normal, no hunner lesion/trabeculations, anesthesia bladder capacity 1100 ML.

Biopsy from Trigone taken and sent for histopathology, report awaited.

Patient tolerated the procedure well. Perioperative period was uneventful. Catheter removed on POD1. Patient is now being discharged in stable condition with following advice.

### ADVICE ON DISCHARGE

Diet

Tab Azee 500 mg per orally once a day for 10 days

Medication

Tab Rostrum D 1 tab per orally once a day before breakfast for 10 days

Tab Clonotril 0.5 mg per orally at bed time

Syp Alkastone 1 tsf in 1 glass of water thrice a day for 2 weeks

Tab Flotral 10 mg per orally once a day at bed time

Tab Voveran SR 50 mg per orally once a day for 3 days

Tab Feburic 40 mg per orally once a day Tab Rozavel F 10 mg per orally at bed time.
