Sensory input deficits: -

a) Visual:

- Ability to attend to any visual stimuli: Present

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Therapy Plan

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Long term Goals:

To improve communication skills within child impairment.

Short terms Goals:

- 1. To improve attention span from level 1 to level 2 on Reynell's attention scale.
 - a) Puzzles.
 - b) Building blocks.
 - c) Color circles and cartoons etc.
 - d) Use torch flash light, rotate it in dark room in different directions.
- 2. To improve Receptive vocabulary in terms of (Reception stands for understanding of information which is delivered to a person.)
- Kinship terms (lineal generation bond: children, parents, grandparents and collateral bonds like; sibling, cousins, aunty, uncles.
 Activity: Parents must show photo of particular person to the child and have to tell the relation with them)
- Lexical categories of nouns (animals, fruits, vehicles, vegetables). Activity: Parents must use pictures or real objects which are available at home. Place fruits in front of child and discuss its name, color and taste, place animals and discuss its shape and how it creates sound. And same for the vehicles
