Brief Summary: -

1 yr old boy diagnosed case of Wilm's tumor, stage III is being admitted with c/o fever. On examination conscious, afebrile, chest-b/l equal AE, CVS-clinically NAD, P/A-soft, testis-B/l normal. He was started on broad spectrum antibiotics after sending the blood culture which was sterile. He also developed loose stools during hospital stay for which Syp. Metrogyl was added. Gradually his fever defervesced, loose stools subsided & oral intake improved. He was also given Week 2 Inj. Vincristine on 04.05.13, which he tolerated uneventfully. At present child is better, general condition is fair and afebrile; he is being discharged in stable condition on 07.05.13.

On examination conscious, afebrile, HR-120/min, BP-80/50mmHg, pallor+, severe dehydration, chest b/l equal AE, CVS-clinically NAD, P/A-soft, testis-B/L normal. He was started on broad spectrum antibiotics & IV fluids. In view of persistent loose stools, syp Normet was added and stool routine examination was done which was normal. Gradually his loose stools improved, vomiting subsided & oral intake improved. At present child is better, general condition is fair and afebrile, he is being discharged in stable condition on 13.10.13.

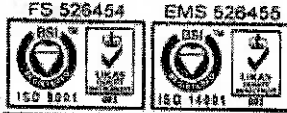

Instructions for Radiology Procedures:

Preparation for Ultrasound:

- Ultrasound Abdomen /Abdominal Doppler: Overnight/6 hours fasting required
- Ultrasound pelvis/Prostate/early pregnancy: No fasting required

Patients should refrain from passing urine immediately before the examination. Patients may be required to drink 1-2 litres of water before the examination so that their urinary bladder is full which helps in better examination.

- Any other ultrasound examination e.g small parts, chest, extremities etc.

No preparation is required.

- For FNAC/Biopsy:

At least 6 hours of fasting required.

Preparation for CT scan:

Patient should preferably not wear any metallic object over his/her body e.g purse, undergarments with metallic zipper, clips or buckle etc.

For Contrast CT– Recent report of Blood Urea and Sr. Creatinine, not more than 15 days old.

Patient should be empty stomach, preferably overnight. If breakfast has been taken, then minimum 6 hours fasting required for contrast CT examination.

For Non-contrast CT examinations like -HRCT/LDCT Chest, Spine, PNS etc. no preparation is required.

MRI:

- Patient should remain empty stomach for 6 hours for contrast MRI. For non-contrast MRI no fasting is required.
- Recent reports of blood Urea and serum Creatinine should be available, not more than 15 days old for contrast MRI only.
- Wear cotton clothes with no embellishments, metallic pins or hooks. Wear no jewellery.
- Dentures to be removed prior to MRI examination. Remove any trans-dermal pain relief patches.
- Remove any wallet, credit card or mobile phone if kept in any pocket.
- Must inform about any pacemaker or metallic implant inside the body.
- May require sedation for claustrophobic patients.

Barium Swallow/Meal:

Patient should come empty stomach in the morning if a Barium meal UGIT is to be done.

For Barium Swallow you need not be empty Stomach.

Barium Enema:

Take light, low residue diet for three days before the test.

- Take 2 tablets Dulcolux and 6 tablets of Charcoal at night for evacuation of bowel and come empty stomach in the morning. Do not eat or drink anything for 12 hours before the test.
- The test will be performed after simple enema in the ward.

**Please note that Diabetic patients and patients on any other medication should consult their doctors before stopping the medication.*

Procedure Description Protocol KV: 100. Dose: 10.3 mSv. I/V contrast: 350 mg/ml. 100ml.

Clinical Indication: WILMS TUMOR OF LEFT KIDNEY STAGE III, Off therapy since Oct 2013. USG- suspicious right kidney SOL.

Findings:

Diffuse fatty infiltration seen in liver parenchyma. Rest of the liver is normal. No focal lesion/dilated IHBR are seen.

Gall bladder, spleen, pancreas, both adrenals and both kidneys are normal.

Left kidney is not seen – post operative.

Right kidney ~ 10.7x5.1 cm and shows normal size, enhancement pattern. A hypertrophied column of bertin in interpolar region. No abnormal mass lesion is seen.

Subcm mesenteric nodes seen.

Urinary bladder is normal.

Prostate is normal.

Subcm mesenteric nodes seen. No retroperitoneal lymphadenopathy/ascites is seen.

Bone window is unremarkable.

Findings:

Liver is normal in size and shows grade 1 fatty infiltration. No focal lesion is seen. IHBR are not dilated.

Right kidney [112 x 516mm.] shows compensatory hypertrophy , with increased echotexture. No hydronephrosis is noted. There is e/o doubtful faint hypoechoic round SOL ~ 19 x 18mm in mid pole causing **splaying of vessels**.

Left kidney is not seen – post op status. No suspicious lesion/collection is seen at post op site

No ascites / retroperitoneal lymphadenopathy is seen.

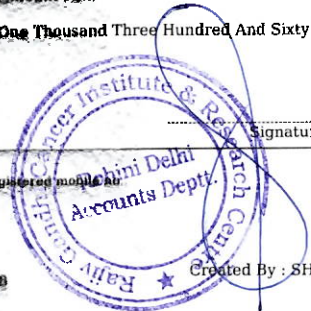



Instructions for Radiology Procedures:

Preparation for Ultrasound:

- Ultrasound Abdomen /Abdominal Doppler: Overnight/6 hours fasting required
- Ultrasound pelvis/Prostate/early pregnancy: No fasting required

Patients should refrain from passing urine immediately before the examination. Patients may be required to drink 1-2 litres of water before the examination so that their urinary bladder is full which helps in better examination.

- Any other ultrasound examination e.g small parts, chest, extremities etc.

No preparation is required.

- For FNAC/Biopsy:

At least 6 hours of fasting required.

Preparation for CT scan:

Patient should preferably not wear any metallic object over his/her body e.g purse, undergarments with metallic zipper, clips or buckle etc.

For Contrast CT– Recent report of Blood Urea and Sr. Creatinine, not more than 15 days old.

Patient should be empty stomach, preferably overnight. If breakfast has been taken, then minimum 6 hours fasting required for contrast CT examination.

For Non-contrast CT examinations like -HRCT/LDCT Chest, Spine, PNS etc. no preparation is required.

MRI:

- Patient should remain empty stomach for 6 hours for contrast MRI. For non-contrast MRI no fasting is required.
- Recent reports of blood Urea and serum Creatinine should be available, not more than 15 days old for contrast MRI only.
- Wear cotton clothes with no embellishments, metallic pins or hooks. Wear no jewellery.
- Dentures to be removed prior to MRI examination. Remove any trans-dermal pain relief patches.
- Remove any wallet, credit card or mobile phone if kept in any pocket.
- Must inform about any pacemaker or metallic implant inside the body.
- May require sedation for claustrophobic patients.

Barium Swallow/Meal:

Patient should come empty stomach in the morning if a Barium meal UGIT is to be done.

For Barium Swallow you need not be empty Stomach.

Barium Enema:

Take light, low residue diet for three days before the test.

- Take 2 tablets Dulcolux and 6 tablets of Charcoal at night for evacuation of bowel and come empty stomach in the morning. Do not eat or drink anything for 12 hours before the test.
- The test will be performed after simple enema in the ward.

****Please note that Diabetic patients and patients on any other medication should consult their doctors before stopping the medication.***
