History & Examination : This, 75 years old male patient is a known case of aforesaid diagnosis, had recent pacemaker programming done showed battery life of > 10 months and on 20.09.2023 during home blood pressure monitoring machine showed decreased pulse rate for which he brought here in Emergency Department and after appropriate evaluation he got admitted for further evaluation and management.

ECG : At admission patient was conscious, oriented  
 Vitals: Pulse 76/min, BP was 159/77 mm Hg, SpO2 98%  
 Paced rhythm.

ECHO : No RWMA, Good LV function , E.F - 55%  
 Hospital Course : Patient was admitted here in Emergency Department with above mentioned complaints and kept there for stabilization where all routine & relevant investigations were done and appropriate treatment was started. His ECG done was in paced rhythm. Patient managed with diuretics, beta-blockers, anti-diabetics, PDES inhibitors, DPP-4 inhibitors and other supportive measures. Patient responded well with given treatment and at present hemodynamically stable and had no decreased pulse rate recorded. Now he is being discharged in stable condition with following advice & medications with 24 hours Holter monitoring.
