DIAGNOSIS :

Rheumatic Heart Disease
Moderately severe mitral stenosis
Mild LV dysfunction
AF with FVR, No CCF, NYHA Class III
Normal coronary arteries

ON ADMISSION :

Physical Examination : No cyanosis, pallor, oedema

Heart Rate : 170 bpm, irregularly irregular

BP : 120/70 mmHg

JVP : Not raised

CVS : S1 loud, P2 loud

Mid diastolic murmur

with presystolic accentuation

Abdomen : Soft, no organomegaly

PROCEDURE: Coronary angiography and Percutaneous transvenous mitral commissurotomy (PTMC) done on 16/02/2018.

Mrs. Rameshwari Devi, 65 Yrs. old female, nonhypertensive, nondiabetic, a known case of rheumatic heart disease was admitted with complaints of palpitation with suffocation and ghabrahat. ECG showed AF with FVR. Her echocardiography revealed moderately severe mitral stenosis with an area of 1.2-1.3 sq cm with dilated LA with mild LV dysfunction (LVEF=45%) with mild global hypokinesia. Routine blood investigations showed deranged kidney functions (Urea 55.26 mg/dL, Creat. 1.31 mg/dL) and raised TLC (14,700 /uL). LFT showed raised SGOT and SGPT levels. Ultrasound chest showed pleural effusion on right side. Urine R/M was done which showed RBCs 5-7. She was managed with IV antibiotics and other supportive treatment. After stabilization, her coronary angiography was done which revealed normal coronary arteries. Her PTMC was done after routine transeptal puncture. The mitral valve was dilated serially with Inoue balloon upto 26 mm. During PTMC the patient had an episode of severe bradycardia for which temporary pacing was done. Post PTMC her mitral valve showed good opening. Her hospital stay was uneventful and she is being discharged in a stable condition.

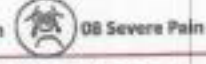

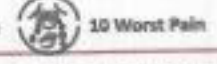
