200 ml of contrast laden saline was instilled in the urinary bladder via a transurethral catheter.


Over distended urinary bladder noted.

Grade-IV right side vesico-ureteric reflux noted.

The micturating cystourethrogram shows a normally structured urethra. The patient micturated forcefully.

No significant residual urine noted.
