Dr. Tarun Mittal, MD, DM (Nephrology) & Dr. Praveg Goyal, MD, DM (Cardiology) opinion was taken & advice incorporated. Patient is now being discharged in hemodynamically stable condition.

STATUS AT THE TIME OF DISCHARGE: Conscious, afebrile, hemodynamically stable condition.

TREATMENT ADVICE AT DISCHARGE:

Tab. Qure 500mg once daily

Tab. Rablet 20 mg 1 tab. twice daily

Tab. Ursocol 300 mg 1 tab. twice daily

Tab. Domstal 10 mg 1 tab. thrice daily

Tab. Nebistar 2.5 mg ½ tab. twice daily

Syp. Lactihep 20 ml HS SOS
